
THE PRE-HEALTH PROGRAM AT DEPAUL





You're on the right track.

The path to a graduate or professional degree in health care can seem daunting—you need an understanding of graduate admission requirements while working toward your bachelor's degree in order to position yourself as a strong candidate. It's a lot to consider and registering for the pre-health program will help you stay on track.

The pre-health program will provide you with:

- Advising from a pre-health advisor throughout your time as a student at DePaul University.
- Opportunities to learn more about undergraduate research initiatives and funding opportunities facilitated through the CSH Office of Advising and Student Services.
- Education and career planning resources to help you make sure that the career you envision is the right one for you.
- Invitations to pre-health events where you will network with other pre-health students and learn how to be a competitive graduate/professional school applicant.
- Access to the Pre-Health Advising Committee (PAC) during your junior or senior year if you meet the eligibility requirements.

These résumé-building opportunities will help you stand out from the applicant pool.

Pre-Health Advising Committee (PAC)

After you have registered as a pre-health program student, earned at least a C- grade in each general biology and general chemistry course, including labs, earned at least 32 credit hours at DePaul University, achieved at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA, and are planning on applying to professional school in the spring/summer of the current year, you are eligible for services from the PAC. PAC services include:

- A dedicated faculty mentor who will assist you through the steps of applying to a professional school.
- Access to events specifically geared toward applying to professional programs.
- The opportunity to receive a pre-health advising committee letter of recommendation to professional schools of interest.

Get a jump on your professional education.

At DePaul, most pre-health students pursue an undergraduate program within a four-year period.

While pursuing your undergraduate degree, you can start preparing for professional school by:

- Registering for the pre-health program
- Checking the pre-health program website for information about professional schools, timelines and checklists
- Meeting quarterly with the pre-health advisor to make sure you are meeting the requirements for your professional health program
- Exploring a variety of health careers through our lunch and learn series
- Getting involved on and off campus through volunteer work, shadowing and research

Pre-health is not considered a major, minor or concentration, therefore any student in any major is able to register for the pre-health program and start taking advantage of its benefits.
