What can a tutor do for me?

- Help me understand material from the class or the book
- Help me review material
- Work through practice problems with me

What will the tutor NOT do for me?

- The tutors will not do my homework for me
- The tutors cannot tell me whether my homework answers are correct
- The tutors do not know what will be on exams, or how the exams will be graded
- The tutors do not know what the instructors allow students to bring with them and use on the exams
- The tutors will not help me with a take-home or online quiz/exam
- The tutors cannot teach me an entire class that I may have missed

Things to remember

- Before you come to see the tutor, review your notes and read the relevant portions of the book. That will help you both focus right in on the areas of difficulty.

- Come with specific questions (“I’m having trouble with this particular computation” is much better than “I don’t understand any of this.”)
- Don’t wait until the last minute to get help.
- Other students have assignments due at the same time as you, so be prepared to share the tutor’s time and attention.
