

- Diarrhea



Attendance at each scheduled therapy session is expected. If an absence is expected, please make every effort to contact the Depaul Speech and Language Clinic (773) 325-7040 at least 24 hours in advance.



- Please assist us in maintaining safe capacity volumes by arriving no more than 10 minutes prior to scheduled appointments.
- Sessions may be canceled by the DPSL Clinic if you arrive more than 15 minutes late for any scheduled appointment; please call the clinic at (773) 325-7040 if you are running late.
  - When sessions begin later than scheduled, session length cannot be extended.
- Please plan to meet clinician(s) in the waiting area before sessions.

#### PARKING INFORMATION

#### **Discount Rate**

Clients are able to park at the Clifton Parking Deck on campus for \$8.00. Please bring your parking ticket with you to the clinic and present it for validation at the time of your appointment.

#### **Full Rate**

Sheffield Garage Cost: \$14.00

Parking passes are available to clients who are unable to access campus parking. These passes are reserved for our clientele with handicap accessibility or financial need. #### **Public Transportation**

The clinic is located just steps from the Fullerton El Station (served by the Red, Brown, and Purple lines) and several bus stops. Buses servicing the campus include #74 Fullerton Avenue, #11 Lincoln Avenue, and #8 Halsted Street. All routes are subject to change by the CTA. #### **Driving Directions**

#### From the north and northwest on I-90/I-94

From the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn left (east.) The Alumni Center is approximately two miles from the expressway on the northwest corner of Fullerton Avenue and Sheffield Avenue.

#### From the west on I-290

From the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290), turn onto the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) heading toward Wisconsin. From the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94) exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn right (east.) The Alumni Center is approximately two miles from the expressway on the northwest corner of Fullerton Avenue and Sheffield Avenue.

#### From the south on I-90/94

From the Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/I-94) continue as the expressway becomes the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94). Exit at Fullerton Avenue and turn right (east.) The Alumni Center is approximately two miles from the expressway on the northwest corner of Fullerton Avenue and Sheffield Avenue.

#### From the north or south on Lake Shore Drive

Exit Lake Shore Drive at Fullerton Avenue. Head west for approximately two miles. The clinic is located on the northwest corner of Fullerton Avenue and Sheffield Avenue.
